Montgomery County Government through the Office of Procurement has issued an LSBRP solicitation for Time and Material Electrical Services. The closing date for this solicitation is **February 17, 2012, at 11:00 AM.**

The scope of summary is as follows:

A contract resulting from this IFB will provide for the performance of Time and Material, and General Electrical/Maintenance/Installation services at County owned/maintained facilities on an as-needed basis. The scope of work includes, but is not strictly limited to the following:

- **Maintenance/Repair:** The Contractor must provide all necessary management, supervision, personnel, overhead, labor, tools, materials and equipment for Electrical Maintenance/Repairs at County owned/maintained facilities. Work may be performed on interior or exterior as requested. Services include systems and control components.
- **New Installation, Renovation and Alterations:** The Contractor must provide all necessary management, supervision, personnel, overhead, laboratory, tools, materials and equipment for electrical installation, renovation and alterations at County owned/maintained facilities. Installations, renovations and alterations, will include exterior and interior applications. The Contractor must work from verbal instructions, sketches or drawing as provided and approved by the Contract Administrator or designee.
- **Regular Working Days and Hours:** Services will be on an as-needed basis upon direction of the Contractor Administrator or designee. All SECTION D - SPECIFICATIONS AND/OR SCOPE OF WORK (Continued) work will be performed by competent Electricians, experienced in commercial electrical services. All work will be first class in accordance with good commercial practice. Regular working hours and days are 6:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding contract Holidays. Any changes in these working hours must be approved in advance. The Contractor must have sufficient resources to respond to more than one job at any given time should the need arise.
